Thank you that you have plans that will prosper me and give me both hope and a future. You, my Savior and Friend, are an awesome God.

Prayer 4

For I Can Do everything through Christ, who gives me strength. – **Phillipians 4:13**

Thank you God for the Courage and Hope you fill me with as I face Life's Challenges. I know Jesus will carry and uphold me through my difficulties today and every day.

Prayer 5

Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need. – **Matthew 6:33**

Prayer 17

Prayer 18
